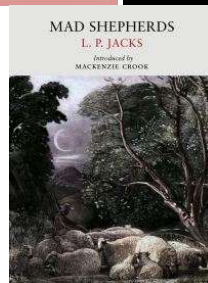
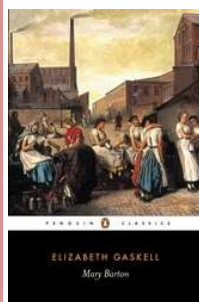
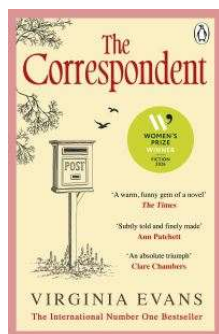

Rosalind Ephraim, Burway Books, Church Stretton, Shropshire Sybil writes letters to everyone in her past and future in Virginia Evans's *The Correspondent*, a novel so immersive you feel sure that she must have written to you as well. For something older, I am rereading an old favourite of mine, *Mary Barton* by Elizabeth Gaskell, a pioneering novel that shows the social consequences of the Industrial Revolution in the north. LP Jack's *Mad Shepherds*, and *Other Human Studies* is an evocative account of Edwardian rural eccentricity. By turns moving, funny and deeply strange, this 1910 book comes with a new introduction by Mackenzie Crook.

In September 1974 a young woman called Rosalind - whose ambition was to read every book published, realized that this was unrealistic, she decided to open a bookshop instead in which a carefully chosen stock would reflect both the knowledge gained from her interest in reading as possible and the interests of customer demands, which turned out to be endlessly fascinating and often quite unpredictable. That bookshop was Burway Books, and it is still run by Rosalind. It remains a small, individual, and proudly independent bookshop based in the same street although not far from its first location, in a larger, warmer building, with hot water! (it's a bit of a quirky building too) in the Church Stretton.
